INTERNATIONAL AWARD UCLG - MEXICO CITY - CULTURE 21 5th edition

The objective of the **International Award UCLG – Mexico City – Culture 21** is to recognise leading cities and individuals that have distinguished themselves through their contribution to culture as a key dimension in sustainable cities.

In 2021-2022, the objective of the 5th edition is to recognise the best practices on the promotion of **cultural rights in the context of the Covid-19 crisis** and post-pandemic recovery, and/or that have promoted **culture as an important part of the caring system**.

The call for applications for the **category "Cities / Local or Regional Governments"** was open from 15 February to 22 April 2022. 101 candidacies from cities and local or regional governments from all continents were received.

Due to the outstanding quality of the applications received, the organisation of the Award found it coherent to extend the number of "the best" over the 50 initially foreseen, and to promote them as "Innovative sparks" or "Planning with care". All these projects are available in the next pages of this document.

These projects will also become good practices in the "OBS", the database of UCLG Culture Committee on cities, culture and sustainable development.

The winners of the Award will be announced in June 2022, in the context of UCLG Executive Bureau in Seville (13-16 June 2022). The Award Ceremony will be celebrated in Mexico City at the end of September 2022, in the context of Mondiacult 2022 (28-30 September 2022).
