



**UCLG Culture Committee
12th meeting
Bilbao, 19 March 2015**

REPORT
8 May 2015

SUMMARY

The 12th meeting of the Culture Committee of United Cities and Local Governments (UCLG) was held in Bilbao on 19 March 2015, in the context of the 1st UCLG Culture Summit, coorganised with the City of Bilbao.

Among the main objectives of the 1st Culture Summit was the approval of "Culture 21: Actions", a document that updates and deepens the operational dimension of the Agenda 21 for culture.

The latter document has guided the activities of the UCLG Culture Committee since 2004.

Culture 21: Actions is the result of a broad process involving consultations, discussions and contributions from academic experts, institutions and activists, and it serves to reaffirm UCLG's vision of culture as a key dimension of sustainable development.

In this way, the meeting of the Culture Committee provided for the adoption of "Culture 21: Actions", to stress its main features and to discuss the Committee's forthcoming activities. Among the latter is the provision of support to cities wishing to implement Culture 21: Actions, the 2nd edition of the International Award UCLG – Mexico DF – Culture 21 and the continuation of the #culture2015goal campaign.

1. Background

The 12th meeting of the Culture Committee of United Cities and Local Governments (UCLG) was held in Bilbao on 19 March 2015, in the context of the 1st UCLG Culture Summit, coorganised with the City of Bilbao.

Among the main objectives of the 1st Culture Summit was the approval of “Culture 21: Actions”, a document that updates and deepens the operational dimension of the Agenda 21 for culture. The latter document has guided the activities of the UCLG Culture Committee since 2004. Culture 21: Actions is the result of a broad process involving consultations, discussions and contributions from academic experts, institutions and activists, and it serves to reaffirm UCLG’s vision of culture as a key dimension of sustainable development.

In this way, the meeting of the Culture Committee provided for the adoption of “Culture 21: Actions”, to stress its main features and to discuss the Committee’s forthcoming activities.

2. Summary of the meeting

2.1. Welcome

Ms. Catherine Cullen, Chair of the UCLG Culture Committee representing the Métropole Européenne de Lille (MEL), opened the proceedings, welcoming participants and presenting the context of the meeting.

Representatives of the cities which make up the Board of the Culture Committee took the floor thereafter:

- Representing Barcelona, which holds one of the Committee’s Vice-Presidencies, Mr. Esteve Caramés, International Relations Officer at the Institute of Culture of Barcelona, stressed that Culture 21 Actions was a step forward for the Committee, since it would allow local cultural policies to be linked with a global movement. He also highlighted the good work done by the Culture Committee in identifying and analysing good practices around the Agenda 21 for culture.
- On behalf of Mexico City, one of the Committee’s Co-presidents, its Secretary for Culture, Mr. Eduardo Vázquez, presented the results of the first edition of the International Award UCLG – Mexico DF – Culture 21, launched in 2014. He argued that the Award had provided the context to give visibility to many good practices in the field of local cultural policy and sustainable development.
- Ms. Manon Gauthier, Member of the Executive Committee of the Montreal City Council, another of the Committee’s Co-president cities, highlighted that Culture 21: Actions was a good tool to connect cultural policies with other dimensions of development and to reaffirm the essential role of cultural aspects in this context. She also underlined the ‘action-oriented’ nature of the new document, which would facilitate its actual implementation.
- Speaking on behalf of Buenos Aires, another of the Committee’s Co-president cities, Ms. María Victoria Alcaraz, Vice-Minister of Cultural Heritage of that city’s Ministry for Culture, described the flexible and adaptable nature of Culture 21: Actions, which should allow for its relevance to a diverse range of cities and contexts. She also highlighted that the new document would allow the Committee to focus its activities on policy implementation, knowledge transfer and the promotion of networking.

- Finally, Ms. Pascale Marchand, Councillor on Music, Performing and Visual Arts for the City of Angers, one of the Committee's Vice-Presidents, described the importance of the Agenda 21 for culture in her city, both in its contribution to cultural policy development and in supporting international relations. She also referred to the need to raise awareness of culture and sustainability through actions, something that served to highlight the meaning of Culture 21: Actions.

Following these contributions, Catherine Cullen took the floor again. Referring to the dynamic nature of culture, she explained that the Agenda 21 for culture needed to evolve as well, and that Culture 21: Actions was illustrative of this.

The Culture 21: Actions document was then approved by participants in the meeting.

Mr. Jordi Pascual, the Coordinator of UCLG Culture Committee, took the floor after this. He described the consultation process that had led to the approval of Culture 21: Actions, and the fact that this new document would serve to strengthen the work done in the context of the Agenda 21 for culture whilst retaining the latter name as the defining element of the UCLG Culture Committee.

He also pointed out that it was necessary to respond to the interest expressed by many cities in implementing Culture 21: Actions. This would be done via a new 'Pilot Cities' scheme, similar to the one implemented in 2014. In this respect, collaboration with cities experienced in the implementation of the Agenda 21 for culture as well as with regional networks would be essential – one example of this was Culture Action Europe, with which a partnership for implementing Culture 21: Actions in Europe had been set up. He also described the work done in identifying and analysing good practices and invited attendees to explore them.

Jordi Pascual presented other activities foreseen by the Committee in 2015. They included the #culture2015goal campaign for the integration of culture in the Post-2015 Development Agenda, which involves other global networks; and the launch of the second edition of the International Award UCLG – Mexico DF – Culture 21, to be granted in 2016.

Finally, he addressed the governance and funding of the Culture Committee, including the following issues:

- The Committee's current governance framework (including the members of the Board, the main duties of each of them and their financial contributions) was agreed upon at the Barcelona meeting (September 2012). On the basis of that decision, Lille took over the Presidency of the Committee, with Buenos Aires, Montreal and Mexico City as Co-presidents and Angers, Barcelona and Milan as Vice-presidents.
- The next meeting of the Committee, in late 2015, will discuss and agree upon a new governance framework (including members of the Board, the main duties of each of them and financial contributions). This meeting is likely to be held in Paris, on 4-5 December, in the context of the UCLG World Council.
- The budget of the Culture Committee should evolve. Whereas between 2012 and 2015, financial contributions by the cities making up the Board have covered the budget almost entirely, in the period 2016-2018 it would be desirable for the budget of the Committee to be based on contributions both of Board members and of Pilot Cities and other funding sources.
- Cities wishing to take part in discussions around the new governance should express their interest, by responding to the call that will be distributed via a Circular in April or May 2015.

Catherine Cullen, Chair of the Culture Committee, asked the Coordinator to prepare a short document describing the main topics relevant for the governance of the Committee, which should be included in the aforementioned Circular. She also stressed that the new Board (2016-2018) should include both experienced and new cities. Finally, she argued that it would be important to increase the number of cities with a strong commitment to the Agenda 21 for culture and which were willing to collaborate actively with the UCLG Culture Committee in the coming years, either as leading or pilot cities.

After this, Catherine Cullen closed the 12th meeting of the Committee.
